**Branson**

Branson is a soft, red, winter wheat developed by AgriPro Wheat. It is a medium height, semidwarf variety with good straw strength. Plant color at boot stage is dark green. Flag leaf at boot stage is erect and twisted. Waxy bloom is present on the head, stem, and flag leaf sheath. Anther color is yellow. Head shape is strap, mid-dense and awnletted. Glumes are glabrous, narrow in width and long in length with oblique shoulders and obtuse beaks. It is moderately resistant to septoria leaf blotch, stripe rust and powdery mildew and has intermediate resistance to soilborne mosaic virus and leaf rust. It is described with up to 0.8% variants.

Branson is protected under the Title V Certification Option of the 1994 Plant Variety Protection Act.

## Cooper

Cooper is a soft, red, winter wheat developed by AgriPro Wheat. It is a medium height, medium maturity, very good test weight wheat. Cooper has very good straw strength. Plant color is blue-green at boot stage. The flag leaf is erect and twisted. Anther color is yellow. Waxy bloom is present on the stem, flag leaf sheath and head. The head is strap mid-dense and apically awnletted. The glume at maturity is short in length and medium in width. Shoulder shape on the glume is oblique with an obtuse beak. Seed shape is ovate.

Cooper is protected under the Title V Certification Option of the 1994 Plant Variety Protection Act.

## Roane

Roane is a soft, red, winter wheat developed and released by the Virginia Ag Experiment Station. It is a full season variety with medium height. Plant color at booting is blue-green. The flag leaf is recurved and twisted. It is resistant to the prevalent field populations of powdery mildew. It also has intermediate resistance to soilborne mosaic and wheat spindle streak mosaic viruses as well as leaf and glume blotch. It possesses a moderate level of resistance to scab. It is resistant to Hessian fly biotypes GP, B, C and E.

Roane is protected under the Title V Certification Option of the 1994 Plant Variety Protection Act and may be sold by variety name only as a class of certified seed. There is no registered class of seed.

## 25R39

25R39 is a soft, red, winter wheat developed by Pioneer Hi-Bred International. Leaf color at booting is green and the flag leaf is recurved, twisted and has a waxy bloom. Anther color is yellow. Spikes are apically awnletted, lax, tapering in shape and inclined at maturity. The seed shape tends to be elliptical. 25R39 has shown very good winter hardiness and resistance to straw lodging. It has excellent resistance to leaf rust and stripe rust and moderate resistance to powdery mildew. It has also shown moderate resistance to the complex of fungal organisms that incite leaf blights.

Application has been applied for under the 1994 Plant Variety Protection Act.

## 25R47

25R47 is a soft, red, winter wheat developed by Pioneer Hi-Bred International. Leaf color at boot stage is green and the flag leaf is erect, twisted and has no waxy bloom. Anther color is purple. Heads are awned, mid-dense, short to mid-long, tapering in shape and nodding at maturity. 25R47 has excellent resistance to the prevalent races of powdery mildew and leaf rust in the Corn Belt. It has very good resistance to septoria tritici, nodorum leaf blotch and tan spot. It also has good resistance to soilborne and wheat spindle streak mosaic viruses. Variants are limited to not more than 1/15,000 in total and may include taller or awnless plants.

25R47 is protected under the 1994 Plant Variety Protection Act.

## 25R56

25R56 is a soft, red, winter wheat developed by Pioneer Hi-Bred International. Leaf color at booting is green and the flag leaf is erect, twisted and has a waxy bloom. Anther color is yellow. Spikes are apically awnletted, mid-dense and tapering in shape and nodding at maturity. 25R56 has shown excellent resistance to stripe rust in the mid-south U.S. region and very good resistance to leaf rust in the northern Corn Belt. It is moderately resistant to the complex of organisms that incite leaf blights including septoria tritici blotch, stagonospora nodorum leaf blotch and tan spot. It has intermediate resistance to prevalent races of powdery mildew and to wheat spindle streak and mosaic virus and to soilborne mosaic virus. It has also shown resistance to Hessian fly biotype L.

25R56 is protected under the 1994 Plant Variety Protection Act.

## W1377

W1377 is a soft, red, winter wheat bred and developed by AgriPro for grain production. W1377 is a medium-tall height wheat that has shown tolerance to the strip rust field races prevalent in 2005. This variety has shown intermediate reaction to leaf rust field races prevalent in the Midwest and upper mid-southern U.S. in 2004, 2005 and 2006. W1377 has shown intermediate reaction to Fusarium head scab, susceptibility to powdery mildew in Michigan and in the East and has shown resistance to Biotypes B and E of Hessian fly. W1377 results in excellence test weight wheat. This variety is adapted to most of the Midwestern and upper mid-southern soft wheat areas. Breeder seed will be maintained by AgriPro and generations of seed to be multiplied will be Breeder, Foundation, Registered and Certified.

W1377 is protected under the Title V Certification Option of the 1994 Plant Variety Protection Act and may be sold by variety name only as a class of certified seed.

# BARLEY

## PAMUNKEY

Pamunkey is a winter barley developed and released by Virginia Polytechnic Institute. It is an early maturing, six row, awned barley. It has good resistance to powdery mildew, scald, net blotch and barley yellow dwarf.

Pamunkey is protected under Title V of the Plant Variety Protection Act and may be sold by variety name only as a class of certified seed.

## PLANT VARIETY PROTECTION ACT

The developer of a new distinct variety may obtain protection (essentially a patent) for that variety if they choose to do so, provided the variety meets the requirements of the Plant Variety Protection Act of 1970 and amended 1994. Two options for plant variety protection are available to the developer of the variety.

Under the first option, the developer of the variety or their agent may sell either certified or non-certified seed of the variety. If the developer of the variety has reason to believe that anyone is infringing on their rights, they may resort to civil action.

The other option ("certification option") for protecting a variety utilizes the provisions of Title V of the Federal Seed Act. A variety protected in this manner may be sold by variety name only as a class of certified seed.

It is the responsibility of the seller to inform the buyer if the variety is protected. Each container of seed sold should be labeled with a tag indicating the type of protection for which the owner has applied. Under the second option, the label will state: "Unauthorized Propagation Prohibited - To Be Sold By Variety Name Only as a Class of Certified Seed - U.S. Protected Variety."

In Indiana, the proper statement is preprinted directly on the face of every certified seed tag used on seed of varieties protected under the "certification option."

## VARIETIES ELIGIBLE FOR CERTIFICATION IN INDIANA

All crop varieties certified annually by the association are listed and described in the Summer and Winter editions of the Indiana Seed Directory.

As new varieties are released and as older varieties fade from the scene, the total list of eligible varieties becomes rather long and somewhat meaningless.

Any questions relating to the eligibility of a specific crop variety for certification should be directed to Indiana Crop Improvement Association. A complete list of all varieties certified in recent years is maintained.

The following companies have produced seed under the Quality Assurance Program. This program provides an unbiased quality control system of field inspection, laboratory testing and post-season growout testing for varieties, brands, and blends.

## NOXIOUS WEED SEED FREE FORAGE AND MULCH CERTIFICATION

There is a growing demand in North America for the use of certified noxious weed seed free forage and mulch as a preventative program to limit the spread of noxious weeds. This voluntary certification program is designed to assure that forage (hay, cubes and pellets) and mulch sold with proper certification identification meets minimum standards designed to limit the spread of noxious weeds. Buyers are provided assurance that forage and mulch certified through this program meets these minimum standards.

The Indiana Crop Improvement Association has been designated as the official Noxious Weed Seed Free Forage and Mulch Certification Agency in Indiana by the Director of Purdue Agricultural Research Programs in consultation with the Indiana State Chemist Office. Program standards comply with the Regional Weed Free Forage Certification Standards developed by the Regional Weed Free Forage Committee of the North American Weed Management Association. The Regional Weed Free Forage Committee has established minimum standards to allow uniform participation by states and provinces in the program. Forage and mulch certified under the ICIA certification program with proper certification markings attached will be eligible to be shipped into restricted areas in the United States and Canada where only forage and mulch certified under the Regional Forage Certification Standards can be used.
