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Seed Lab Technician

The Seed Lab Technician assists in the preparation, processing, and analysis of seed samples submitted for warm germination, vigor, and purity and noxious testing to determine seed quality.

Key Responsibilities

- ✿ Receive and divide seed samples.
- ✿ Plant and evaluate warm germination and vigor tests.
- ✿ Conduct purity and noxious analyses and identify contaminant seed.
- ✿ Assist with other tasks as determined by the Lab Director or Lab Supervisors.

Qualifications

- ✿ Must be at least 18 years of age and received a high school diploma or equivalent.
- ✿ Previous experience is preferred but not necessary. Training is provided. Preference will be given to those with a bachelor's degree or those currently pursuing a degree in Agriculture or related fields.
- ✿ Must be able to lift at least 25 pounds to carry supplies and other materials.
- ✿ Work may involve the use of specialized chemicals requiring safety precautions.

Additional Information

- ✿ The Seed Lab Technician is a part-time non-exempt position that may work up to 40 hours per week during the peak season of September through April.
- ✿ Starting hourly wage is based on experience.
